The Parkers have an innovative partnership with the City of Gunnison on the Van Tuyl Ranch, as well as other private landowners throughout the Western Slope, through which they lease land. With a focus on regenerative grazing to produce grass-fed beef, they have been able to double production on the ranches they manage. They also have experience in direct marketing and distributing Parker Pastures beef and lamb throughout Colorado.

They offer workshops and farm tours in partnership with Cold Harbor Institute, a non-profit facilitating education, incubation and demonstration of regenerative personal, community and land practices.

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
