These records provide detailed information regarding food origin, product traceability through the supply chain, verification that all participants have complied with Federal and State regulatory laws. Consumer can see exactly where their food is grown, the farming practices used, the journey the food took through the supply chain, and the unique nutritional values it has compared to other products on the shelf. A consumer only needs a smartphone app, or a Blockchain enabled website, to determine which food products are the cleanest, healthiest, most ethically and environmentally produced.
